- Who: All Girl Scouts
- What: 100th Anniversary Patch Design contest
- Designs due: June 1, 2010
- Where: 100th Anniversary Patch Contest, GSCB, 501 South College Ave., Newark, DE 19713
- How: Patch designs should be submitted to GSCB on the Patch Contest Entry Form by the due date. The 100th Anniversary Committee selects a team to review submissions. This panel of judges will select one entry to be the winning patch design.
- Criteria: Eligible any registered Girl Scout Daisy, Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior, Ambassador or Adult.
- Patch designs must contain, but are not limited to:
- 1) Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay or GSCB
  - 2) 100th Anniversary or 1912—2012
  - 3) Size – the finished patch will be 2 inches by 3 inches and can be any shape
  - 4) Patch colors should be kept to a maximum of 5 colors, not including the border. The border of the patch can only be one color.
  - 5) Letters need to be at least 3/8" tall
  - 5) Artwork should be original and created by you. No trademarked or copyrighted material will be allowed. (May use the Girl Scout Logo.)

### Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to any registered Girl Scout (*Daisy to Adult*) – individual entries only.
2. Entry must be submitted with colors indicated.
3. Submit a color print or indicate color placement on a black and white patch design.
4. Entry submitted with a completed "100th Anniversary Patch Contest Entry Form."
5. Troops can not submit one entry representing the Troop.
6. Each girl/adult in the Troop may submit an entry.
7. All entries from Troop can be mailed together.
8. Only one design per sheet of paper. More than one entry may be submitted.
9. All entries must be mailed to the 100th Anniversary Patch Contest, GSCB, 501 South College Ave. Newark, DE 19713. In order to be displayed and/or considered for the design contest, the Patch Design Release must be signed for each entry. Entries without release signature filled out completely will not be considered. Participants name, address, phone number, email address (*if available*), GS Troop # (*or individually registered girl*), and program level must be included.
10. Entries must be postmarked no later than June 1, 2010.
11. By entering the design contest, artists consent to allow the use of their first names, stories, and/or photographs for advertising, publicity or publication for this or similar promotions without further compensation.
12. Entries will not be returned and GSCB cannot confirm submissions received due to the anticipated high volume of entries.
13. All entries and designs will become the property of the GSCB. The winning design may be re-drawn or touched up so we can successfully manufacture a patch; however, we will not lose the integrity of the design.
14. Late, illegible, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, or postage due entries will not be considered.
15. Winner will be notified by telephone, email, or mail.
16. Entries will be judged based upon the criteria for the patch design (*dimensions, colors, design elements, etc.*)
17. Judges decisions are final.
